

How to use Locate (iOS, Android)

About Locate:

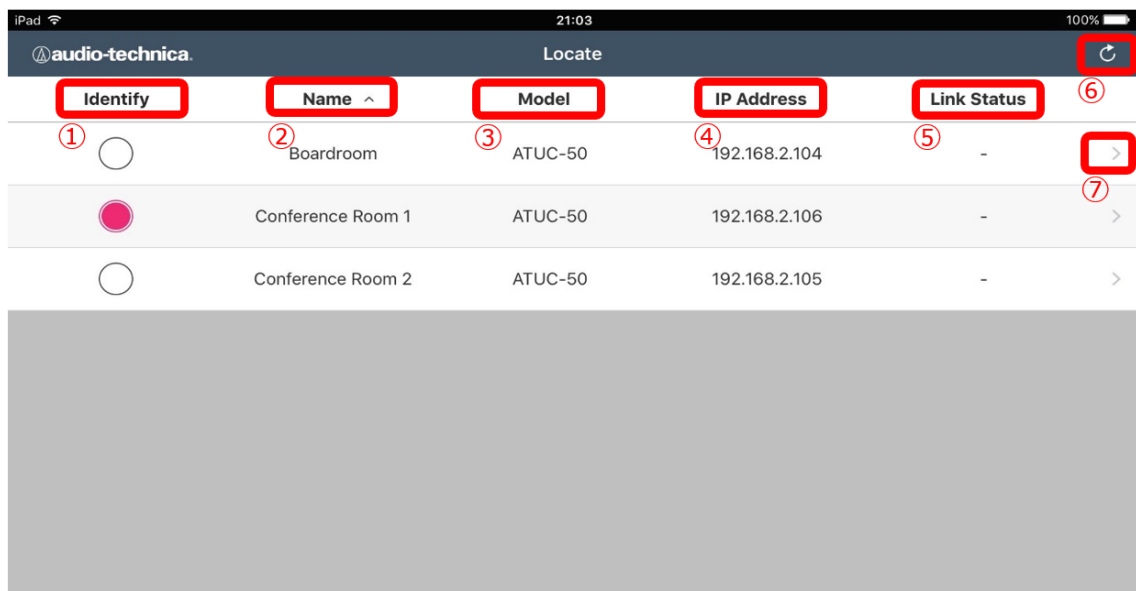
- Audio-Technica Locate enables you to use a smartphone or tablet to easily connect to and control Audio-Technica units present on the local wireless network.
- The simplified set up doesn't require knowledge of a unit's IP address. All units that have their discovery setting turned on are automatically detected and listed by the app.

System Requirements:

- Android OS4.4 or later.
- iOS 8 or later (compatible with iPhone, iPad, and iPod Touch).
- Requires a Wi-Fi connection between the smartphone or tablet and the Audio-Technica units.

Locate Screen:

Locate lists the units detected on the network and displays their Link status.

| ① | Identify | By clicking the LED icon, the front panel of the corresponding unit will blink. |
| ② | Name | Displays the name of each unit. Clicking on [Name] sorts the list in ascending or descending alphanumeric order. |
| ③ | Model | Displays the model number of each unit. Clicking on [Model] sorts the list in ascending or descending alphanumeric order. |
| ④ | IP Address | Displays the IP address of each unit. Clicking on [IP Address] sorts the list in ascending or descending numerical order. |
| ⑤ | Link Status | Displays the Link status, Primary or Extension, of linked devices. Clicking on [Link Status] sorts the list in ascending or descending alphabetical order. |
| ⑥ | Refresh | Clicking on the Refresh icon refreshes the list. |
| ⑦ | [>] (Open) | Clicking [>] connects the smartphone or table to the selected unit and opens up its Web Remote home page. |
