

How to use Locate (Windows, OSX)

About Locate:

- Audio-Technica Locate enables you to use a computer to easily connect to and control Audio-Technica units present on the network.


- The simplified setup doesn't require knowledge of a unit's IP address. All units that have their discovery setting turned on are automatically detected and listed by the app.

System Requirements:

- Microsoft Windows 7 or later.
- Mac OS X 10.10 Yosemite or later.
- Requires a LAN connection between the computer and the Audio-Technica units.

Locate Screen:

Locate lists the units detected on the network and displays their Link status.



①	Identify	By clicking the LED icon, the front panel of the corresponding unit will blink.
②	Name	Displays the name of each unit. Clicking on [Name] sorts the list in ascending or descending alphanumeric order.
③	Model	Displays the model number of each unit. Clicking on [Model] sorts the list in ascending or descending alphanumeric order.
④	IP Address	Displays the IP address of each unit. Clicking on [IP Address] sorts the list in ascending or descending numerical order.
⑤	Link Status	Displays the Link status, Primary or Extension, of linked devices. Clicking on [Link Status] sorts the list in ascending or descending alphabetical order.
⑥	Refresh	Clicking on the Refresh icon refreshes the list.
⑦	Open	Clicking [Open] connects the computer to the selected unit and opens up its Web Remote home page.
